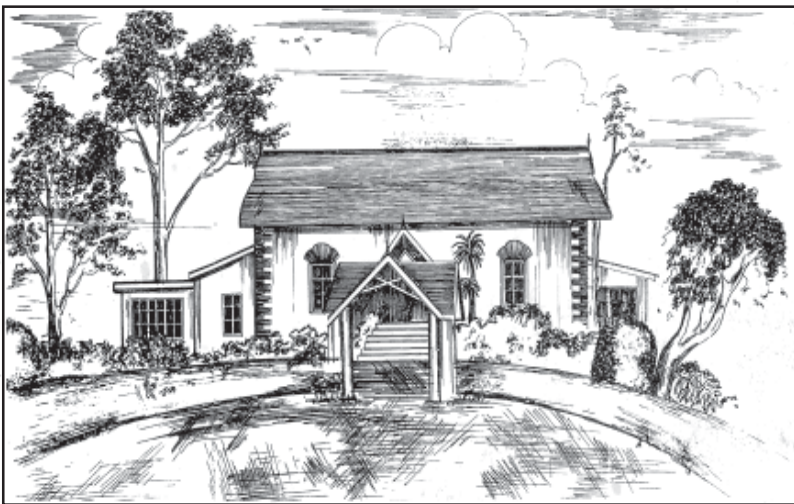

INTER-CLUB AFFILIATIONS

We have affiliation with 69 Clubs across the country and one in Colombo, Srilanka.

ACCOUNTS

Finance: During the financial year 2017 – 2018, we have incurred Rs. 25,06,652.04 as excess of expenditure over income, compared to Rs. 26,76,017.50 excess in income during the previous financial year. The reason for the increase is mainly on account of increased Establishment / Administrative and other charges, Repairs & Maintenance and also Depreciation. The Capital Expenditure incurred during the financial year 2017 – 2018 is Rs. 19,07,505.60 against Rs. 99,22,731.00 during the last financial year.

Accounts: The Finance & Accounts Sub Committee keeps a strict visit on our Accounts. We are having a Management Accounting Report which is presented in our monthly meeting. It is further discussed in detail and correct up measures are taken. As far as possible we adhere to our approved budgets for the year.

TAXATION

Luxury Tax: The review petitions (Appeals), filed in the year 2009, for the assessment years from 1991 – 1992, by the Commercial Tax Officer, Coonoor, before the Honorable High Court of Madras is pending disposal.

Income Tax: 1.) In the matter of levy of income tax on the interest received from bank deposits, an appeal has been filed for the Assessment years 2001-2002 to 2007-2008 in the Supreme Court and is pending.

2.) The Income Tax Appeal for the Asst. year 2006 – 2007 is pending disposal before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal, Chennai.

3.) The assessment orders for the assessment years 2008- 2009 to 2013- 2015 are yet to be received.

4.) The total liability towards Income Tax up to assessment year 2016-2017 have been fully paid. (Refer Notes on account 2 (d) of schedule 24).

Wealth Tax: The appeal filed before the Honorable Supreme Court is pending disposal. Contingent liabilities towards Luxury Tax and Wealth Tax have been adequately covered by creating a Contingency Fund. However the actual liabilities towards these two items have to be ascertained to evaluate the fund position more accurately. The Auditor has been advised to compute the actual liabilities to date on these accounts.

CHAMBERS

The Chambers were refurbished and some of the old furniture has been changed. The rooms are well patronized. Our members and guests appreciated our food & services and upkeep of Chambers. We are getting positive comments from the room occupants and our endeavour is to improve further wherever possible.

If any Complaints or Suggestions are received, we attend to this immediately. The Committee Member is constantly monitoring all activities.

CATERING

We are getting appreciation for the food provided to our Members and Guests and also from private parties.

BAR

Our bar is having a good stock of Imported & Indian Liquor catering to the need of all sections. The bar is well patronized.

PROGRAMS AND ENTERTAINMENT

We are holding regular Saturday Night Dinners, Gala Night, Sunday Special Lunches which attracts good turnout of Guests, Members & Children. We hold Music Programs, Plays Sports & Games and other interesting programs regularly every month.

Deepavali was celebrated with Dandiya Dance, followed by Dinner. Onam, Christmas & New Year was celebrated which was well attended and appreciated.

ANNUAL DAY

The 'Annual Day' was celebrated on 26th May 2018. We had conducted Annual Tournaments with good participant from Members. The Annual Day Dinner was well attended and we ended up the day with a DJ Programme.

LIBRARY

The Book Lovers Club with the Book reading events were held. We got good participation for this event. The Library is well patronized and we are purchasing new books for the library with the help of our regular Book Readers. Also we purchase popular Magazines and Periodicals in addition to our Newspapers. The Committee appreciates the efforts of a few members of our club for the time and commitment spent for processing new books for the Library.

Fixed Assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation has been provided on written down value method at the rates provided and methods of prescribed in the Income Tax Rules.
- c) Investments:
Investments are stated at cost.
- d) Inventory:
Inventory is valued at lower of Cost or Realisable Value
- e) Retirement Benefits:
The Club is covered by Employees Provident Fund Act. Accordingly contributions are made as per the Act and Rules.
Provision for Gratuity has been made in terms of Payments of Gratuity Act, 1972.

2. TAXATION

- a) Wealth Tax:
The appeal on Wealth Tax Matters is pending decision of the Supreme Court.
- b) Luxury Tax:
The Writ Petitions filed before the Honorable High Court of Madras, had been decided in favour of the Club.
The Department of Commercial Taxes represented by the Commercial Tax Officer, Coonoor, had filed a second appeal in the Honorable High Court of Madras. The appeal is pending disposal.
The Luxury Tax demand for the financial years 1991-92 to 2001-02 aggregating to Rs.33,54,143.00 has not been provided in the accounts since it is in the nature of contingent liability and may crystallise depending upon outcome of judgment.
- c) Income Tax:
The Judgement in the Madras High Court was not in favour of the Club and our appeal is pending before the Supreme Court.
The total tax liability of Rs.8,31,273.00 pertains to the financial year 2016-17 corresponding to the Asst-Year 2017-18 of Rs. 8,31,273.00 have been charged to the various fund accounts on the basis of the ratio of interest earned on the deposits as detailed below:

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BUDGET GENERAL MEETING OF THE COONOOR CLUB HELD ON WEDNESDAY 28TH MARCH, 2018 AT 6.30 P.M. AT THE COONOOR CLUB, COONOOR.

President Mr. S.Rajubettan called the meeting to order at 6.30 p.m. and advised the Chief Administrative Officer Mr. G. Sudheendran to start the proceedings.

Item No 1: To read the notice calling the BGM:

Mr. G. Sudheendran started the proceedings of the Budget General Meeting by reading out the notice convening the meeting.

Item No 2: Obituary:

A minute's silence was observed in memory of Mr. B.N. Balachandran, Mr. Mohan A Menon, Mr. J.R. Stedman, Mr. M.C. Parikh, Mr. V.K. Rajaram and Mr. P.C. Bhansali.

Item No 3: To approve and adopt the Revised Estimate for the year 2017 - 2018 and Budget for the year 2018 - 2019.

The President informed the floor that the Revised Estimate for the year 2017 – 2018 and the Budget for the Financial Year 2018 – 2019 already been circulated to the members, and he also asked the floor if there any queries in the Budget.

There were no queries from the floor.

INCOME AND EXPENDITURE: BUDGET 2018 - 2019

1. SALARY, WAGES & ALLOWANCES:

Mr. J.C. Anand informed the floor that an amount of Rs. 4,36,599.00 towards Staff Season Exgratia has been omitted under the head of Salary, Wages and Allowances. The total Budget for the year 2018 – 2019 for Salary, Wages and Allowances will be read as Rs. 91,41,147.00 instead of Rs. 87,04,548.00. He also informed that as per the Labour Act No: IC No: 35 dated 18th July 2014 the Minimum wages have been increased and the Staff Salary increase has gone up.

The Members of the floor asked that the strength of the staff can be reduced. Mr. J.C. Anand informed that 4 Staff Members will be retiring from service due to Superannuation. If we reduce more staff that will affect the regular maintenance and service of our club.

The President Mr. S. Rajubettan said that we get major income from the Chambers and he also thanked Mr. Thomas C Oommen for meticulously finalizing the accounts on a monthly basis.

2. RATES AND TAXES:

Mr. Thomas C Oommen informed that the Rates and Taxes Budget for the year 2018 - 2019 has been increased from Rs. 9 lakhs to almost Rs. 13 lakhs due to increase in the Property Tax and increase in the Imported Liquor Licence Fee. The Property Tax rates have been revised by the municipality. Mr. S.N. Raju also said the Property Tax calculation is Rs. 400/- per sq.ft approximately.

Mr. J.C. Anand informed that our club has been classified under Hotels and Restaurants and our charges for the Property Tax is as per the Commercial Rates and he has also informed that our club imported liquor rates have been reduced approximately Rs.30/- per peg.

After detailed discussion proposed by Mr. V.M. Desai the Income and Expenditure Budget was unanimously approved.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE 2019 – 2020:

BUILDING, FURNITURE AND FITTINGS: S.No: 1 (1.1) & 2 (2.1)

Mr. J.C. Anand informed the floor to approve the Proposed Capital Expenditure for the year 2019 – 2020 for constructing Four New Chambers including Furniture and Bathroom fittings of Rs. 72,00,000/- to be taken up the in the current financial year as we got the approval from the concerned departments.

Mr. Thomas C Oommen informed the floor that the budget cash outflow figure for the year 2018 – 2019 will be Rs. 1,87,05,000.00 and the net cash inflow / (outflow) amount will be Rs. -(1,34,00,348.00). He also called for suggestion from the floor presence. Our major Capital Income is derived from the Entrance Fee. As Revenue Income is still in the negative, ways and means have to be found to offset the increasing revenue deficit.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE FOR 2018 – 2019:

1. BUILDINGS

1.5 BILLIARDS ROOM ROOF CHANGING (2000 sqft) - Rs. 30,00,000.00

Mr. S. Rajubettan said that the Billiards Room roof is in a very bad condition and during the rainy season there is a leakage in the roof. Mr. V.M. Desai had asked the amount of Rs.30 lakhs, is it only to repair the roof work. The President replied that the amount is not only for the roof work, it is for the entire Billiards Room renovation and this work will be taken up immediately.

Mr. Thomas C Oommen suggested the floor, that the members approve this expenditure immediately for taking up the work.

After detailed discussion proposed by Mr. V.M. Arjun the Capital Expenditure Budget was unanimously approved.

GENERAL DISCUSSIONS:

Mr. V.M. Arjun suggested for one more well for the club, the president said that we already have two wells and we are getting sufficient water. He also said that our club is going to do the proper rain water harvesting work.

Mr. V.M. Desai recommended to have the Solar Water Heater Power System to the Chambers. Mr. J.C. Anand said that this will be very expensive. He already enquired from various places and he also said that a hotel in Ooty is using reverse water pump water heating method made by Venus Water Heater Company and he said that he has already discussed with them, told them to come and give a demo at the club. Interested members may come and see the demo.

Mr. V.M. Arjun informed that there is a crack in the Synthetic Tennis Court and it has to be done immediately. The President asked him to get the quotation from the professionals.

Mr. V.M. Arjun said that the Gym Room has been converted into a new chamber and are we going to construct a new Gym Room. Mr. J.C. Anand explained while constructing the sports complex, we will be constructing the Gym Room. Mr. Vikram C Devaraj has already finalized the Sports Complex plan.

After the general discussions the Revised Estimate for the year 2017-2018 and the Budget for the year 2018-2019 was unanimously approved and passed.

There being no further business, the meeting closed with a vote of thanks at 7.30 p.m.

EXISTING BYE - LAW: 24.

ELECTION OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS

(a) Seven Members to form the Committee shall be elected by ballot at the Annual General Meeting of the Club. They shall hold office until Annual General Meeting to be held in the second year. They shall not be eligible to serve on the Committee for more than TWO consecutive terms.

A list of such members shall be placed on the notice board ten clear days before the meeting. Those Members who have not cleared their dues as per Bye- Law 17(a) before submitting their names will not be eligible to stand for election.

PROPOSED BYE - LAW: 24.

ELECTION OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS

(a) Seven Members to form the Committee shall be elected by ballot at the Annual General Meeting of the Club. They shall hold office until Annual General Meeting to be held in the second year.

(b) Those Permanent Members of a minimum of five years standing, who are willing to serve on the Committee, shall submit to the Honorary Secretary or CAO as the case may be their names fifteen clear days before the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting. The Honorary Secretary / CAO shall send out the list of members who are willing to serve on the Committee to all Permanent Members at least ten clear days before the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting. A list of such members shall be placed on the notice board ten clear days before the meeting. Those Members who have not cleared their dues as per Bye- Law 17(a) before submitting their names will not be eligible to stand for election.

5. To consider to add a new Bye - Law to be numbered as 28 (f)

PROPOSED BYE - LAW: 28. (f) Paperless Office:

A **paperless office** (or **paper-free office**) is a work environment in which the use of paper is eliminated or greatly reduced. This is done by converting documents and other papers into digital form, a process known as digitization. Proponents claim that "going paperless" can save money, boost productivity, save space, make documentation and information sharing easier, keep personal information more secure, and help the environment.

A copy of the Annual Report and Finance statement mentioned above shall be posted on the club web site 21 days prior to the Annual General Meeting and shall also be simultaneously exhibited on the Notice Board at the Club.

Any member require a hard copy of the Annual Report and Finance statement shall submit in writing to the Honorary Secretary / Chief Administrative Officer at least 15 days prior to the AGM.

Note: We are holding a minimum of three General Body Meeting in a financial year, average cost for printing and posting is Rs. 1,00,000/- per year.

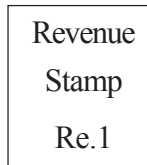

The proxy form shall be duly stamped and must be lodged in the hands of the C.A.O/HonorarySecretary at least 72 hours before the time fixed for the holding of the meeting at which the person named therein proposes to vote. The giver of the proxy may specify on the document the items of the Agenda on which alone his proxy may vote on his behalf. As to other items the proxy shall be void and have no effect. Failing such limitation the proxy vote shall be exercised in regard to all the items of the Agenda.
